What information we collect, use, and why

We collect or use the following information to provide and improve products and services for clients:

- Names and contact details
- Addresses
- Occupation
- Payment details (including card or bank information for transfers and direct debits)
- Usage data (including information about how you interact with and use our website, products and services)

We collect or use the following personal information for the operation of client or customer accounts:

- Names and contact details
- Purchase or service history
- Account information, including registration details
- Marketing preferences

We collect or use the following personal information for the prevention, detection, investigation or criminal activity:

- Names and contact information

We collect or use the following personal information for information updates or marketing purposes:

- Names and contact details
- Profile information

We collect or use the following personal information to comply with legal requirements:

- Name
- Contact information
- Client account information
- Biometric information (where used to identify someone)

We collect or use the following personal information for dealing with queries, complaints or claims:

- Names and contact details
- Photographs (where used to identify someone for the purpose of carrying out a contract)
- Biometric information (where used to identify someone)

Lawful bases and data protection rights

Under UK data protection law, we must have a “lawful basis” for collecting and using your personal information. There is a list of possible lawful bases in the UK GDPR. You can find out more about lawful bases on the ICO’s website.

Which lawful basis we rely on may affect your data protection rights which are in brief set out below. You can find out more about your data protection rights and the exemptions which may apply on the ICO’s website:

- **Your right of access** - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information. How long we keep information

We keep data records about you for as long as you are in an active contract with us, and for 6 months after you end your contract with us. After this time we securely remove your data from our database.

Others we share personal information with

- Professional or legal advisors if absolutely necessary for your safety
- Emergency services if absolutely necessary for your safety

How we protect your personal data

We are fully GDPR compliant. Your data is stored under strict confidentiality in a secure online database. We use the strongest possible browser encryption to conduct our business.

While we take all reasonable precautions to ensure that user data is secure and that users are protected, there always remains the risk of harm. The Internet as a whole can be insecure and therefore we are unable to guarantee the security of user data beyond what is reasonably practical.

Children

We do not knowingly collect or use personal data from children under 16 years of age. If we learn that we have collected personal data from a child under 16 years of age, the personal data will be deleted as soon as possible. If a child under 16 years of age has provided us with personal data their parent or guardian may contact our privacy officer.

How to complain
